

General Service Commercial Rates Outside the Marquette City Limits: R3

Who May Take Service: Any rural customer for general purposes with less than a 25 KW demand.

Territory Applicable: All territory served by the Marquette Board of Light and Power outside the city limits of Marquette, Michigan.

Hours of Service: Twenty-four hours daily.

Character of Service: Single or three phase, alternating current, 60 hertz, at standard available voltages.

Rate: Fixed Charge: \$48.00 per month

Utility Review Committee Charge: \$0.11 per month

Plus Energy: All KWH \$0.1550 per KWH

Minimum Charge: The minimum charge shall be \$48.00 per meter.

Contract: None required.

Rules Applying: Service is governed by the Marquette Board of Light and Power's Standard Rules and Regulations.

Conjunctural billing will not be permitted in cases where the customer is presently being served lighting and power loads through separate meters. In these instances, whenever the customer at their expense will arrange their wiring to receive energy through one single metered service, then this rate shall apply to their entire requirements if their demand is less than 25 KW.

Effective: All bills issued after October 1, 2016.
