

Power Service Commercial Rates Outside the Marquette City Limits: R5

Who May Take Service: Any rural customer for light and power purposes when the metered demand is 25 KW or greater, but less than 200 KW.

Territory Applicable: All territory served by the Marquette Board of Light and Power outside the city limits of Marquette, Michigan.

Hours of Service: Twenty-four hours daily.

Character of Service: Single or three phase, alternating current, 60 hertz, at standard available voltages.

Rate: Utility Review Committee Charge: \$2.11

Plus Demand: 25 KW or less \$437.50

Over 25 KW \$17.50 per KW

Plus Energy: All KWH \$0.1120 per KWH

Minimum Charge: The minimum charge shall be \$437.50 per meter.

Determination of Billing Demand: Billing demand shall be the maximum 15 minute demand during the month but not less than 25 KW.

Contract: May be required under the Marquette Board of Light and Power Rules and Regulations.

Rules Applying: Service is governed by the Marquette Board of Light and Power's Standard Rules and Regulations.

Effective: All bills issued after October 1, 2016.
