LARGE POWER “OFF SEASON” ACCOUNT BILLING

All Large Power, U6 and R6 accounts (not customers) which have been U6 or R6 accounts and received electric service for sixty consecutive months are eligible. Commencing with the sixty-first month of continuous electric service and during each following year of continuous service thereafter, an account is eligible for Large Power “Off Season” Account Billing.

Demand must be 25 kw or less for all of one of two approximately four month, “off season” periods, one commencing with the account’s meter reading in November and the other commencing with the May meter reading date. A U6 or R6 authorized account representative must nominate the “off season” period in writing by the first day of October or April, whichever appropriate.

Minimum monthly demand billing for six months of each calendar year is 200 kw.

Monthly demand billing for selected “Off Season” period is 25 kw.

Participating accounts exceeding 25 kw actual demand during selected “Off Season” period will receive 200 kw demand billing for entire four month “Off Season” period, retroactively if necessary.

Energy consumed throughout calendar year will be billed at the appropriate U6 or R6 rate.

The Marquette Board of Light and Power will endeavor to notify participating account of projected November or May meter reading date two weeks prior. Actual reading date dependent on manpower scheduling and weather.
