Standard Connection Fees

Transfer Service	\$20.00
Connect Service: during business hours	\$50.00
Connect Service: after business hours	\$150.00
Connect Service by Line Crew: during business hours	\$150.00
Connect Service by Line Crew: after business hours	\$350.00
New Permanent service	\$50.00
New Temporary Service	\$85.00
Up to one span of overhead secondary including service drop	When inadequate or no transformation exists, there will be a \$750.00 charge for single phase and \$3,000.00 charge for three phase installations

Miscellaneous Fees & Charges

Non-Sufficient Fund (NSF) fee	\$25.00
Delinquent Collection Fee	\$50.00
Co-Generation Application Fee	\$300.00
DPF- Late Payment Fee	\$5 or 2% (whichever is greater)
Meter Testing (Customer Requested)	No charge for initial request. Any subsequent requests for the same account within 4-year period will be billed at a Time and Material rate.
Energy Use Audits	No charge for initial request. Any subsequent requests for the same account within 4-year period will be billed at a Time and Material rate.

MBLP Line Extension Contributions in Aid of Construction

New Primary Line Extension - Residential Service	MBLP will contribute up to \$3,200 towards installation of primary distribution infrastructure.
New Primary Line Extension - Garage, Barn, Mobile Home, RV, Truck Heater, Etc.	MBLP will contribute up to \$1,000 towards installation of primary distribution infrastructure.
Subdivision Developer MBLP Contribution for New platted Subdivision	MBLP will contribute up to one-half (½) of the standard Residential Line Extension contribution per lot toward the installation of primary and secondary distribution infrastructure required to provide service to each lot.
Subdivision Large Estate Style Lot – Primary Extension (For Residential Service)	For residential lots with service locations greater than 250 feet from the point of connection, MBLP will contribute up to one-half (½) of the standard Residential Line Extension contribution toward primary extension within the lot.
Non-Residential and Commercial Extensions	MBLP contribution in aid of construction will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis, based on load requirements and overall project scope.
